- 3) Each individual has the right to be safe and to be treated with respect and dignity.
- 4) We shall use our best endeavours to ensure that:
 - All allegations of abuse are taken seriously.
 - The response to them is swift and appropriate.
 - The effectiveness of our policy is renewed annually.
- 5) A responsible person shall be appointed annually as Child Protection Officer to whom members can express their concerns.
